



CMS DISCLAIMER FOR MACHINE-READABLE URL PUBLIC USE FILE (PUF)

CMS strongly recommends that third parties that wish to reuse or republish this data review the following disclaimers and display substantially similar language on their web sites in a prominent and conspicuous manner.

a. Formulary Drug List Disclaimer

This disclaimer details the sources and nature of the data, including potential limitations, and specifies the responsibility of the data user in regard to the processing and understanding of the data files.

Under 45 C.F.R. 156.122(d)(2), QHP issuers in Federally-facilitated Exchanges (FFE) must provide up-to-date, accurate, and complete lists of all drugs covered by the plan to HHS in a format and at times specified by HHS.

Data accuracy: Persons who use this information should note that these data may not be current or otherwise accurate. QHP issuers must update their formulary information in a machine-readable format not less than monthly, and issuers may update this information at various dates throughout the month. CMS imports the data directly from issuers daily.
