LEGAL NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM

Effective on **September 28, 2024**, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with Hygeia Home Care, Inc. A Medicare complaint validation survey conducted on August 23, 2024, found Hygeia Home Care, Inc was not in compliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations and conditions in the facility constituted immediate jeopardy (IJ) to resident health or safety.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has determined that Hygeia Home Care, Inc was not in compliance with the following three Medicare Conditions of Participation for Home Health Agency (HHA) services:

42 C.F.R § 484.105 Organization and Administration of Services 42 C.F.R § 484.110 Clinical Records 42 C.F.R § 484.55 Comprehensive Patient Assessments

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after September 28, 2024. For patients admitted prior to September 28, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.

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
