New ASETT One Pager and Infographic Available

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) National Standards Group (NSG), on behalf of the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS), has released two new resources explaining how to use the <u>Administrative Simplification Enforcement and Testing Tool (ASETT)</u>. Through ASETT—a free, online tool—individuals and organizations can <u>test electronic health care transactions</u> and <u>file a complaint</u> against a Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) covered entity for noncompliance with <u>Administrative Simplification</u> requirements.
