

# **Annual Clotting Factor Furnishing Fee Update 2022**

### **Provider Types Affected**

This MLN Matters Article is for physicians, hospitals, other providers, and suppliers who submit claims to Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) for furnishing a clotting factor to Medicare patients.

#### **Provider Action Needed**

Make sure your billing staff knows the clotting factor furnishing fee for 2022 is \$0.239 per unit.

## **Background**

Section 1842(o)(5)(C) of the Social Security Act requires Medicare to pay a furnishing fee for items and services associated with clotting factor. CMS includes the clotting factor furnishing fee in the published national payment limits for clotting factor billing codes. Your MAC will make payment for the clotting factor and the furnishing fee when the national payment limit for a clotting factor isn't on the Average Sales Price Medicare Part B Drug Pricing File or the Not Otherwise Classified Pricing File.
