# **Background**

There's an April 2022 quarterly release of the edit module for clinical diagnostic laboratory services. According to the <u>Medicare Claims Processing Manual, chapter 16, section 120.2</u>, CMS updates the laboratory edit module as necessary to reflect coding updates and substantive changes to the NCDs.

The changes are a result of coding analysis decisions developed under the procedures for maintenance of codes in the negotiated NCDs and biannual updates of the ICD-10-CM codes. This allows us to process laboratory claims subject to 1 of the 23 NCDs (see <a href="Medicare NCD Manual">Medicare NCD Manual</a>, sections 190.12 - 190.34) uniformly throughout the nation.
