



## Opioid Treatment Program: Learn How to Bill Medicare

Opioid Treatment Programs (OTPs) provide medications for people diagnosed with an opioid use disorder (OUD). Medicare pays for OTP services for OUD treatment when you're:

- Certified by SAMHSA and accredited by an independent, SAMHSA-approved accrediting body
- Enrolled in the Medicare program as an OTP and have a provider agreement
