Hospice Quality Reporting Reminder

The Calendar Year (CY) 2020 HQRP data began January 1, 2020 for hospices to meet the quality reporting requirements that apply to BOTH Hospice Item Set (HIS) and the CAHPS® Hospice Survey requirements. Data from CY 2020 impacts your Annual Payment Update (APU) in FY 2022. To ensure your hospice achieves its full APU, please be sure to meet the quality reporting requirements:

- **For HIS:** The threshold for HIS is 90%. This means that 90% of all HIS assessments must be submitted and accepted within 30 days of the admission or discharge date.
- **For CAHPS:** All Medicare-certified hospices that are required to conduct the CAHPS® Hospice Survey Hospices must contract with an approved CAHPS® Hospice Survey vendor and conduct the survey for 12 months in each calendar year. CAHPS® Survey Size Exemption Reminder

The 2020 Size Exemption form for small hospices is now available on the <u>CAHPS Hospice Survey website</u>. Hospices with fewer than 50 survey eligible patient/caregiver pairs in 2019 are eligible to fill out the form and submit it for an exemption from data collection in 2020. The form will be up until December 31, 2020.

CMS is developing a new patient assessment tool to be proposed in future rulemaking. As finalized in the <u>Fiscal Year 2020 Hospice Wage Index and Payment Rate Update and Hospice Quality Reporting Requirements Final Rule</u>, the hospice patient assessment instrument is identified as the Hospice Outcomes & Patient Evaluation (HOPE).
