Add	Extirpation	Definition: Taking or cutting out solid matter from a body part
Add		Explanation: The solid matter may be an abnormal byproduct of a biological function or a foreign body; it may be imbedded in a body part or in the lumen of a tubular body part. The solid matter may or may not have been previously broken into pieces
Add		Includes/Examples: Thrombectomy, choledocholithotomy
Add	Introduction	Definition: Putting in or on a therapeutic, diagnostic, nutritional, physiological, or prophylactic substance except blood or blood products
Add	Monitoring	Definition: Determining the level of a physiological or physical function repetitively over a period of time

<i>Add</i>	External	Definition: Procedures performed directly on the skin or mucous membrane and procedures performed indirectly by the application of external force through the skin or mucous membrane
<i>Add</i>	Open	Definition: Cutting through the skin or mucous membrane and any other body layers necessary to expose the site of the procedure
<i>Add</i>	Percutaneous	Definition: Entry, by puncture or minor incision, of instrumentation through the skin or mucous membrane and any other body layers necessary to reach the site of the procedure
<i>Add</i>	Percutaneous Endoscopic	Definition: Entry, by puncture or minor incision, of instrumentation through the skin or mucous membrane and any other body layers necessary to reach and visualize the site of the procedure
