

Upcoming Enhancement to the Workers' Compensation Medicare Set Aside Portal (WCMSAP)

Collection of Prescription Drug Information

September 18, 2014



Introduction

This presentation provides an overview of the WCMSAP enhancement that supports the inclusion and capture of prescription drugs on Workers' Compensation cases submitted through the WCMSA portal. Included in this presentation are descriptions of the new and revised WCMSAP pages as well as screen images.



Overview

- As of October 6, 2014, portal users will be able to enter information on the new Prescription Drugs page for any new and Work In Progress case before it is submitted through the WCMSAP.
- Entry of the prescription drug information will be required, when applicable, prior to submission of a case using the portal.
- As is the current procedure, prescription drugs will be verified and priced using the monthly Redbook Drug Reference that is in effect at the date of submission.
- The new and revised WCMSAP pages that support entry of prescription drug information are as follows:



Prescription Drugs Page

- The Prescription Drugs page displays after a user clicks [Next] on the Diagnosis Codes page.
- This page requires users to indicate if a claimant is currently taking or is expected to take prescription drugs as a result of the workers' compensation injury.
- If prescription drugs are anticipated, the user will click the [Drug Lookup] button to locate and select the applicable drug(s).

Redbook Rx Search

- The Redbook Rx Search page displays after the user has clicked the [Drug Lookup] button on the Prescription Drugs page.
- Users will enter their search criteria (Form, Drug Name, Dosage and Route of Administration) and then click [Search].
- The system will return all results that match the Rx search criteria on the bottom portion of this page. Users will select the applicable drug.
- Once the applicable drug has been selected, the portal will display the following information related to the selected drug on the Prescription Drugs page: drug name, dosage, NDC, PPU (Price per Unit) and the number of years (based on Life Expectancy).
- Once populated, users will be required to enter the drug frequency information i.e., Per Day, Per Week or Per Month and calculate the total by clicking the [Calculate Total] button.

- This will transfer them to the Redbook Rx Detail page where they can view the Rx Detail and Pricing History.
- In addition, users can click a link to be transferred to the Rx Historical Detail page to view historical pricing information.
