The webinar is postponed due to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) examining the implications of the ICD-10 provision in the recently enacted *Protecting Access to Medicare Act of 2014* and will provide guidance to providers and other stakeholders soon on the implementation of OASIS-C1.

Purpose

On, March 31, 2014, the Congress passed the *Protecting Access to Medicare Act of 2014* which may delay the implementation of ICD-10 coding, which is included in OASIS-C1. CMS is currently studying the provisions of the Act and the implications on the proposed implementation of OASIS-C1, and will provide guidance to providers and stakeholders. Until such time as guidance is provided, we cannot proceed with the webinar as scheduled.

On, April 30, 2014, the Survey and Certification Group is sponsoring a webinar on "OASIS-C1". The topics of this 1 ½ hour webinar include:

• The new OASIS-C1 data set and its implementation, scheduled for October 1, 2014;

- Types of changes made to the data set;
- OASIS-C1 Guidance Manual changes; and
- OASIS Q&As update.
