

OVERALL PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RESIDENCE HISTORY QUESTIONNAIRE

1. Place Type Definitions are as follows:

The purpose of defining place type in Residence History is to define stays in long-term care units in order to collect data for an appropriate period of time, e.g., use of acute care services, expenditures, health status, etc.

Long-term care: The facility or unit must contain 3 or more beds and meet at least one of the following requirements.

Beds certified by Medicare or Medicaid as nursing home beds, intermediate care facility beds, or intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded beds. These facilities may include nursing homes, nursing units of larger facilities, rehabilitation facilities, institutions for the mentally retarded, and hospice units in acute care hospitals.

Licensed as a nursing home or personal care facility, or some other type of long-term care facility. Other long-term care facilities include personal care homes, assisted living facilities, board and care homes, domiciliary care homes, rest homes, and mental health or psychiatric long-term care hospitals.

Provides 24-hour a day supervision by a caregiver.

Routinely provides help with at least one activity of daily living such as bathing, dressing, shopping, walking or getting about, eating and communicating.

Community Stays: Stays in places determined not to be long-term care facilities. These include private homes or apartments, independent living facilities or units, and hospital stays from which the SP does not return to the facility.

Hospital Stays: Stays in hospitals which have not been classified by the home office as either a long-term care facility or as a community stay. **Hospital** is an **interim status** which will be classified as a facility or community stay before the next interview depending on where the SP was staying during the current interview.

2. Data Elements

There are some data elements that occur throughout these Residence History (RH) specifications, and that programmers, testers, and other reviewers may wish to keep in mind.

The current end of round reference period date. This date sets the end of facility data collection for the current round. It is the earliest of date of death, date of discharge from Residence History or the date of interview.

The "end-of-previous-round reference period."

The "most recent date of discharge during the previous round."

The "admission date reported by the previous source." This is used for all crossover and transfer SPs as the starting point for collecting the Residence History, and is the date reported by a previous facility or community respondent as when the SP began staying at the current facility.

3. Set-up Items

The set-up items perform two functions: first, they verify or collect certain items necessary to continue with the Residence History; and second, they establish the current round reference period. Examples of the first function include verifying the First Admission Date (FAD) and collecting date of birth. The second function depends on the SP's vital status. If the SP is alive and a continuing resident, then the previous round reference period is from the end of the previous round reference period through the current round date of interview. If the SP is deceased or discharged and is a Continuing Facility Resident (CFR), then the current round reference period runs from the end of the previous round reference period through the date or death or date of discharge.

PRE-STAY ITEMS

This is the first section after set-up items to be completed for all supplemental sample members in their first round of data collection. Stays prior to the First Admission Date (FAD) will be probed to identify all places where the SP was a resident during the sample admission year.

STAYS

This section of data collection determines whether the SP has spent one or more nights in another unit of the facility, a hospital, or any other place. If the SP has not spent one or more nights in any other place, the timeline is complete. We continue asking these questions until the answer is "NO." Stays are collected chronologically from the end of the previous interview reference period or REF DATE to the end of the current interview (CRIN) reference period.

DATE QUESTIONS

For each place identified, on the matrix we will collect the start date or end date of the stay.

TIMELINE MATRIX/FORM

Place Roster. All places reported during the Residence History will be consolidated on the facility-level Place Roster. The first entries on the Place Roster will be the personal care units, general nursing units, and special care units within the facility and the units affiliated with the facility which were collected during the facility-level data collection. Whether these units are eligible LTC facilities, hospitals, or community places will also have been defined during the facility-level data collection.

Interviewers will select from or add to the Place Roster all places reported during the Residence History data collection for each SP in the facility. The type of place will be collected and defined during Residence History data collection for all places added to the Place Roster. The purpose of the Place Roster is to consolidate reported places to relieve data-collection burden. Interviewers will search the Place Roster first for reported places, and if there is a match, will select the place so it will be linked to the Residence History stay record. If there is no match, the interviewer will add the place to the Place Roster.

The flow of questions is directed within the timeline matrix according to whether the place is selected from or added to the Place Roster. If the place is a facility unit, the question flow is directed to forming the timeline. If the place is hospital, the question flow first goes to Hospital Questions and then the flow is directed to forming the timeline again. If the place is an other Place, the question flow first goes to the Other Place Questions and then the flow is directed to forming the timeline again.

Hospital Questions. This section collects the name, address, and type of hospital for each new hospital identified. The first time it is reported, the AHA will be searched to try to find it (see below). For all hospitals the AHA identifies as having a SNF unit/wing, the interviewer asks whether this stay was in a Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) wing or unit of the hospital.

Other Place Questions. This section collects the name, address, and type of place. For each place, place type will be collected by asking the respondent to classify the place. Places classified as long-term care will be searched for on the NHPI (at the end of the Residence History). Places classified as "community" will have additional questions in order to ascertain with whom the SP was living and whether the SP received home health services while there.

TIMELINE MATRIX DISPLAY (STAY ROSTER)

Several questions throughout the body of Residence History contain the instruction "display Timeline." The basic specifications for displaying the timeline are:

1. Display the timeline as a roster inside a box at the bottom of the screen that has room for four lines, with each line representing one Residence History stay.
2. Each line should have four elements: the name of the place, the start and end dates of the stay, and the stay type (PLACKIND). If any date component (month, day, or year) is refused, substitute "RF" in the timeline display; if any date component is not known, substitute "DK". Otherwise, zero-fill the date displays.
3. The lines should always be displayed in chronological order, from top to bottom.

In addition, there are two variations on which lines should be displayed, depending on whether the questions are being administered as part of pre-stay or Timeline. If coming from pre-stay, display the information for the current stay (i.e., that stay for which CAPI is now collecting information) in the top row, followed by (up to) the next three stays in chronological order. These next three stays may or may not include the FAD, depending on how many pre-stay stays have already been reported. Examples:

In this first example (a live SSM that is still in the facility on 5/18/96, date of interview), we are collecting data about the independent living unit stay. The FAD stay is clearly visible on the second line, and there are not yet any other stays. In a situation with many pre-stay stays, we may not be able to see the FAD stay:

For timeline stays, we should also display the current stay, as the last line. Again, what else the interviewer can see depends on how many stays have been reported:

This SP has a FAD of 12/12/95, and we are in the middle of picking up information about a hospital stay. If there are several stays, the timeline might look like:

In this case, the timeline display shows the current stay as the last line, along with the three preceding stays. The italicized stays are not shown on the timeline display which can only display four lines.

NATIONAL HEALTH PROVIDER INVENTORY (NHPI)

Once the Residence History data collection is completed for an SP, interviewers will search the NHPI for all places identified as LTC places. The frame used for the sample, the NHPI, will be loaded on each interviewer's laptop computer. Interviewers will search the NHPI in an attempt to match nursing homes and other long-term care institutions identified during Residence History. All nursing homes and other long-term care places will be searched on the NHPI because interviewers and respondents have difficulty classifying long-term care places and because of births on the frame.

HOSPITAL PROVIDER DIRECTORY (AHA)

Interviewers will search the Hospital Provider Directory the first time a hospital is reported in order to collect the address. The frame used for the Hospital Provider Directory will be the American Hospital Association file of hospitals. We will flag hospitals with SNF wings or units, as certified by the Health Care Financing Administration, and use that flag to ascertain whether that stay was in the SNF unit of the hospital. Stays in the SNF unit of the hospital will be flagged as eligible long-term care stays. Stays in hospitals with no flag for a SNF unit will be classified as hospital stays.

MGMT SYSTEM SPEC. for all of Residence History:

- Unless otherwise specified, allow DK and RF.
- DK must be retrieved with another facility respondent; if still missing after all respondents have been interviewed, code as FINAL DK.
- Set current Date of Interview (DOI) to "today".

Else, for all SPs, if date entered is after end of current round reference period, display message: "Date cannot be after {CURRENT ROUND END OF REFERENCE PERIOD}. Please re-enter."

OTHER NURSING HOME OR REHAB CENTER:

Nursing homes are licensed or certified facilities that provide nursing services 24 hours a day to the residents. Rehabilitation centers provide skilled nursing care or rehabilitation services and other related health services.

PERSONAL CARE HOME OR RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY:

Personal care homes and residential care facilities or apartment buildings offer residents help with activities, such as bathing and dressing, but do not provide 24-hour nursing services. (Some residents at a residential care facility may not require such assistance, but it must be available to them.) These facilities are sometimes called assisted-living communities, personal care homes, board and care homes, or domiciliary homes.

CCRC OR RETIREMENT CENTER OR HOME:

CCRC and retirement centers or homes may have nursing home facilities on a campus along with other housing and services, such as apartments, board and care services, and often a variety of community-based long-term care services.

Long-term care facilities provide a residence, some surveillance and available living assistance for persons no longer willing or able to live on their own for the long-term.

Residential care facilities offer help with activities such as bathing and dressing but do not provide 24-hour nursing services. Include assisted living communities, board and care homes, domiciliary homes, group homes, personal care homes, and homes for persons with mental illness or retardation.

Services provided by an agency or paid independent provider who comes to the person's home to provide medical care, personal care, or homemaker services due to a physical or mental health limitation or impairment. These services may be provided by nurses, therapists, homemakers, or home health aides.

RH36

A formal discharge is defined by the facility, i.e., whatever the facility defines as a formal discharge is a formal discharge. It may mean that the person is not charged even though the bed is held.

In some states, Medicaid requires a person be formally discharged whenever she goes to a hospital. Medicaid may reimburse the nursing home, usually an amount lower than the normal per diem rate during a hospital stay. There is usually a maximum number of days that Medicaid will reimburse, and this varies by state.
